DENTAL RELEASE FORM

I authorize Abbey Animal Hospital to receive and provide care for my pet _____. I understand that all precautions will be taken to ensure the safety and health of my pet during his/her stay. I also understand that every attempt will be made by doctors and staff to notify me prior to additional medical treatments or cost. If however, I cannot be reached, I authorize Abbey Animal Hospital to perform the necessary lifesaving procedures for my pet at our discretion. I assume full responsibility for all medical expenses incurred during my pet's stay.

_____ (initials) To prevent the spread of infectious disease and parasites, all animals must be current on all vaccines and free from internal and external parasites. I have either provided current records or I authorize Abbey Animal Hospital to vaccinate and treat for internal and/or external parasites, as is necessary.

_____ (initials) I understand that all anesthesia involves some risk to my pet including (very rarely) death and unforeseen complications such as infection, bleeding with certain dental procedures. I am aware that many pre-existing conditions can be identified prior to the dental by performing in house blood diagnostics.

REQUIRED FOR PETS OVER 7 YEARS OF AGE (OPTIONAL FOR UNDER 7 YEARS OF AGE, BUT STILL RECOMMENDED)

_____ (initial) PREOP Blood work I **DECLINE** the preop bloodwork and my pet is under 7 years of age, and understand the risks involved in not having it done.

DENTAL SEALANT

We offer SANOS dental sealant to all patients undergoing professional dental cleanings. SANOS Veterinary Dental Sealant is a one-step application by the veterinarian that helps keep the teeth of dogs and cats clean. SANOS is applied after every professional dental. SANOS seals the subgingival gumline against the formation of plaque. One application lasts up to 6 months. There is an additional charge.

EXTRACTIONS

_____ (initials) During the course of the examination and cleaning, loose or decayed teeth may be found. Unhealthy and decaying teeth can lead to further health complications for your pet including, but not limited to heart disease. If, in the Licensed Veterinary technician's professional judgment, these teeth should be removed, I understand that there will be a charge of \$30.50 per tooth for the first 3 teeth (non surgical). The total additional cost for 4-7 teeth extracted (non-surgical) will be \$125. If 8 or more teeth are extracted (non-surgical), the total additional cost is \$175. These costs **DO NOT** include medications such as pain meds or antibiotics that may be recommended by the doctor.

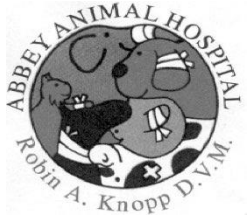
NON-SURGICAL FACILITATED EXTRACTION COSTS (does **NOT** include medications):

\$30.50 per tooth up to 3 \$125 for 4-7 teeth \$175 for 8 or more

DON'T WASTE THE ANESTHESIA!

Your pet will be going under general anesthesia, which affords an opportunity to perform procedures that may be more difficult when your pet is awake. Anesthesia is much safer now than in years past, so we recommend making the most of this event. **Please initial any and all of the following procedures you would like performed while pet is under anesthesia.**

1. ***Toenails can be trimmed** much closer. Long toenails can be painful and contribute to lameness. They can become broken and infected if not trimmed regularly. In some cases a laser nail trim may be preferred, at an additional charge. _____(initials)
2. **Ears can be flushed.** Ear infections are common, and if not attended to, can be very uncomfortable and lead to serious ear conditions and/or surgery. _____ (initials)
3. **Sanitary grooming can be performed** at this time. This may not be easily done in an awake animal but can be easily performed under anesthesia. Fecal matter and Urine can cling to the fur (especially long hair) and can be breeding grounds for bacteria and fungal infections not to mention maggots in warm weather. **A full grooming is not recommended at this time** due to any potential complications. _____ (initials)
4. **X-rays (i.e. those hips, elbow, and stifle radiographs), blood, stool, urine, and other samples can be easily acquired at this time.** This is a great time to collect samples as long as the regular blood work is OK for anesthesia. _____(initials)
5. ***A Microchip** can easily be placed to help you find your lost pet. _____ (initials)

*Nail trim & microchip charges are discounted when done while pet is under sedation.
